With	DO	DON'T
Timeframe	If the process of change is constant and progressive, restructuring won't neccesarly be a hit to the company. Restructuring can be addressed in a long term, which is typical of companies in expansion or maturity phase.	Do not start the process of restructuring in an urgent manner, as this will entail radical changes difficult to accept by the agents.

Human Resources	The management team must have sufficient capacity for leadership to engage the rest of the organization changes. Adaptation of the templates to manufacturing needs, greater variability of wage costs of any type and flexibility of resources.	Do not start the process of adaptation immediately.
Working processes	Reduce the capacity to adapt new production and if it is necessary, stop investments. Optimization of resources and redefinition of tasks, by eliminating those inefficient. Avoid uncontrolled consumption.	To forget to improve the productivity of the company.
Technological changes	Implementation of new technologies adapted to new production systems.
